Sailor Quarterly Report (Stuart Ragland)

Reviewed highlights from the FY 16 Quarterly Report

- Database use statistics include logons via public libraries and K-12 schools.
- Top 10 Pages on Sailor Web Site note popularity of the Maryland Public Library Directory and Marina Services.
- Web Hosting Services (WSHS) data illustrates ongoing value of service to local groups.

MDLIBTECH (Stuart Ragland)

- Brief review of history of the Sailor Network Management Group (SNMG) and its revitalization as MDLIBTECH, a forum for bringing together library based IT staff and managers.
- Dec 8, 2015 MDLIBTECH Conference:
 - o 130 total attendees including 30 from Maryland academic libraries.
 - Speakers on emerging technology, patron driven tools and mobile devices, changing ILS systems, linked data.
 - Exploring potential links with Maryland Library Association, Technology Committee.



Sailor Network (Mike Walsh)

- Moving the last public library (Chestertown Branch, Kent County) from wireless service to Bay Country fiber is complete.
- With fiber backbone, all libraries will now have the ability to extend bandwidth for managing existing services.
- Bandwidth upgrades are in progress for the following libraries:
 - Rockville/Montgomery from 200 mbps to 300 mbps
 - o Denton/Caroline from 200 mbps to 300 mbps
 - Snow Hill/Worcester from 50 mbps to 100 mbps
 - Cambridge/Dorchester from 500 mbps to 700 mbps (also supports Talbot, Queen Anne's and Kent counties)
 - o Towson/Baltimore County from 100 mbps to 200 mbps
- As a result of fiber conversion, FY2016 will likely record the last reduction in Sailor Network costs.

Relais/MARINA Update (Wendy Allen)

- All libraries moved to new Relais portal; the new client software resolved the issue with ESRL and some others were having accessing the portal through a proxy server. All URLs were changed to https: With the changeover some transaction statistics may need to be reconstructed.
- Due to staff changes Prince George's County not lending during December 2015.

Collections and Access Services Division and SLRC Update (Wendy Allen) Renovation at Pratt Central

- End of October all MILO and collection management staff moved to temporary space in Annapolis Road Library Operations Center (ARLOC).
- Next move will be book collections to ALOC, and library administration to temporary Charles Street Library Administrative Center (CSLAC).
- All SLRC public service points are now consolidated on the library's first floor.
 - Roving Reference with Microsoft Surfaces continues.
 - Currently testing Aerohive wireless network option for future implementation and roving telephone reference support.

Collections and Budget

- Expenditure Report for Q1 attached
- Sailor Databases Review Committee is finalizing negotiations with vendors for FY17 (i.e Ebsco, ProQuest, Gale) new content availability July 1, 2016.
- It appears that cost increases will be no more than two percent.
- Expanded content likely to include Rosetta Stone for public libraries, and additional do-it-yourself titles.
- Participating libraries will also have the options to add Flipster databases at 25% discount.



- Heritage Quest, the most used Sailor database, will be licensed separately from ProQuest.
- Baltimore City's current hiring freeze and purchasing review has made some financial transactions cumbersome.
